# **INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT**

# **Board of Trustees University of Louisiana Monroe Foundation**

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of the University of Louisiana Monroe Foundation (a nonprofit organization – the Foundation) which comprise the statements of financial position as of June 30, 2019 and 2018, and the related statements of activities and changes in net assets, functional expenses and cash flows for the years then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements.

### Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America; this includes the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

# Auditors' Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. Accordingly, we express no such opinion. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

### **Opinion**

In our opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Foundation as of June 30, 2019 and 2018 and the changes in its net assets and its cash flows for the years then ended, in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

#### Other Matters

Our audit was conducted for the purpose of forming an opinion on the financial statements as a whole. The information identified in the accompanying Index as Schedules 1-7 is presented for purposes of additional analysis and is not a required part of the financial statements. Such information is the responsibility of management and was derived from and relates directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements. The information has been subjected to the auditing procedures applied in the audit of the financial statements and certain additional procedures, including comparing and reconciling such information directly to the underlying accounting and other records used to prepare the financial statements or to the financial statements themselves, and other additional procedures in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. In our opinion, the information is fairly stated in all material respects in relation to the financial statements as a whole.

### **Emphasis of Matter**

As discussed in Note 1 to the financial statements, the Foundation adopted Accounting Standards Update No. 2016-14, *Not-for-Profit Entities (Topic 958)*, *Presentation of Financial Statements of Not-for-Profit Entities*, in the current year related to the presentation of the financial statements. Our opinion is not modified with respect to this matter.

### Note 1 - Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

#### **Organization**

The University of Louisiana Monroe Foundation (the Foundation) is a legally autonomous fund-raising organization that raises funds for the benefit of the University of Louisiana Monroe (the University), its faculty and its students. Support is received through gifts, grants and bequests, and may include cash, real property and personal property. Funds may be invested by the Foundation in accordance with its investment policy subject to any restrictions imposed by the donor. Disbursements are made for scholarships, academic support and departmental funding. The Foundation has no transactions related to the University's Athletic programs.

The Foundation is a nonprofit corporation exempted from Federal income taxes as "other than a private foundation" under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The Foundation has evaluated its position regarding the accounting for uncertain income tax positions and does not believe that it has any material uncertain tax positions. The Foundation is no longer subject to examination by tax authorities for years ended before June 30, 2016.

#### **Basis of Presentation**

The financial statements have been prepared on an accrual basis and in conformity as required by the *Not-For-Profit Entities* Topic of the Accounting Standards Codification (the Codification).

# Financial Statement Classification

#### Classifications

The net assets of the Foundation are reported as follows:

- Without Donor Restrictions includes all resources to be used in support
  of the Foundation's operations at the sole discretion of the Foundation.
  This classification replaces the previous classification unrestricted net
  assets.
- 2. With Donor Restrictions includes amounts that have been donated for the use of specific University departments, organizations or other beneficiaries. The donations and earnings, if any, are held by the Foundation until requested by the applicable department, organization or beneficiaries and may not be spent at the discretion of the Foundation. It also represents amounts contributed to the Foundation that are subject

to restrictions imposed by the gift instruments. Contributions to endowment funds are not available for use during the term of the applicable trust agreement. However, the Foundation's investment and spending policies provide for a specified amount of the earnings from such funds to be available for scholarships or for expenses of designated departments of the University as specified by the individual agreements.

#### Contributions and Promises to Give

In accordance with the *Revenue Recognition* subtopic of the Not-For-Profit Entities Topic of the Codification, contributions received are recorded as with donor restrictions or without donor restrictions depending on the existence or nature of any donor-imposed restrictions. When a restriction expires, with donor restricted net assets are reclassified to without donor restrictions, as appropriate, and reported in the Statement of Activities as net assets released from restrictions. Contributions are recognized as support when received or when an unconditional promise to give is received. However, all contributions received that qualify for matching funds from the State are recorded as increases in the liability, Funds Held as Agent, and are not reported on the Statement of Activities.

Unconditional promises to give are recognized as revenue in the period received. Promises to give are recorded at their realizable value if they are expected to be collected in one year and at their fair value if they are expected to be collected in more than one year. Conditional promises to give are recognized only when the conditions on which they depend are substantially met and the promises become unconditional. Management has determined that no allowance for doubtful accounts is needed.

#### **Donated Services and Materials**

Noncash donations include both materials and services. These donations are recorded at their fair market value on the date of donation. Donated services are recognized only when they create or enhance a nonfinancial asset, or when they are specialized skills provided by entities or persons possessing those skills that would be purchased if they were not donated.

#### Allocation of Expenses

The costs of providing the various programs and other activities have been summarized between Program and Supporting Services in the Statement of Activities. All expenses are directly assigned to one of the functional categories. Program Services expenses are those directly related to the various programs such as scholarships, academic support and departmental expenses. Supporting Services expenses reflect fundraising and management & general expenses incurred in operating the programs. Fundraising expenses support efforts to raise money for the nonprofit, and include such things as conducting and publicizing fundraising campaigns, maintaining donor lists and preparing and distributing fundraising materials. Management and general expenses are those costs associated with the overall function and management of the organization, and include many personnel costs, accounting and legal fees, and outlays for equipment and supplies. They constitute the organization's overhead costs and represent the reasonable proportion of monies that provide for an organization with strong internal controls and well-managed risks.

#### Property and Equipment

The Foundation capitalizes acquisitions of property and equipment with unrestricted funds in excess of \$1,000 or the fair market value on the date of donation. Costs of property and equipment purchased with unrestricted funds that are less than \$1,000 are charged to expense. The cost of these assets that is classified as program services expense is not capitalized by the Foundation as these assets are owned and used by departments of the University of Louisiana Monroe. Acquisitions of these assets with restricted private donations are also not capitalized by the Foundation as these assets belong to the State of Louisiana. Capitalized assets are carried at cost or, if donated, at the approximate fair value at the date of donation. Depreciation is recorded on a straight-line basis over the estimated useful lives of the assets. The Foundation utilizes estimated useful lives of 5 to 7 years for farm equipment and office equipment and 20 years for buildings. Depreciation of \$33,221 and \$33,221 for 2019 and 2018, respectively, was charged to expense.

#### Cash and Cash Equivalents

For Statement of Cash Flows purposes, the Foundation considers all highly liquid investments with an original maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

The Foundation, at times, may have deposits in excess of FDIC insured limits. Management, however, believes the credit risk associated with these deposits is minimal.

#### Accounting Pronouncements Issued and Adopted

The Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) has issued Accounting Standards Update (ASU) 2014-09, *Revenue from Contracts with Customers*, to update its revenue recognition standard to clarify the principals of recognizing revenue and eliminate industry specific guidance as well as help financial statement users better understand the nature, amount, timing, and uncertainty of revenue that is recognized. This standard will be effective for periods beginning after December 15, 2018.

On August 18, 2016, the FASB issued ASU No. 2016-14, Not-for-Profit Entities (Topic 958): Presentation of Financial Statements of Not-for-Profit Entities. Under the ASU, the number of net asset classes is decreased from three to two; enhances disclosure of underwater endowments are required; reporting of expenses by function and nature, as well as an analysis of expenses by both function and nature is required; and qualitative information in the notes to the consolidated financial statements on how it manages its liquid available resources and liquidity risk is required. This ASU was adopted for the year ended June 30, 2019. Prior presented periods have been restated.

#### Accounting Pronouncements Issued but Not yet Adopted

In February 2016, the FASB issued ASU 2016-02, *Leases*. This accounting standard requires lessees to recognize assets and liabilities related to lease arrangements longer than 12 months on the consolidated statement of financial position as well as additional disclosures. The updated guidance is effective for annual periods beginning after December 15, 2019

In June 2018, the FASB issued ASU No. 2018-08, Not-for-Profit Entities (Topic 958), Clarifying the Scope and Accounting Guidance for Contributions Received and Contributions Made. The amendments in this ASU should assist entities in (1) evaluating whether transactions should be accounted for as contributions (non-reciprocal transactions) within the scope of Topic 958, Not-for-Profit Entities, or as exchange (reciprocal) transactions subject to other guidance and (2) determining whether a contribution is conditional. This ASU is effective for the Foundation for the annual period beginning after December 15, 2018.

The Foundation is currently assessing the impact of these pronouncements on its financial statements.

#### Accounting Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial

statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

#### Subsequent Events

Management has evaluated subsequent events through December 17, 2019, the date the financial statements were available to be issued and have determined that no additional disclosure or adjustments are necessary.

The Helen Spyker Estate, which consists of farmland, timberland, and oil and gas reserves, is included in unrestricted net assets, along with other parcels.

Unrestricted net assets include the Cloverleaf Simmental Farm, which was donated to the Foundation in December 1985. It is reflected in the Statements of Financial Position at its carrying value at \$3,137,317. The Foundation was required to use the majority of the farm acreage for agricultural and educational purposes until December 2015. No changes have been made, nor are there any plans to change the use of the property at this time. However, the land value has been moved to Unrestricted Net Assets as of June 30, 2016, due to the restrictions being satisfied by the passage of time.

Net assets with donor restrictions include a piece of property in Columbia, Louisiana, which was donated to the Foundation in April 2001. It is reflected in the Statements of Financial Position for its appraised value of \$58,000.

#### Note 4 - Investments

All investments in equity securities with readily determinable fair values and all investments in debt securities are reported at fair value with gains and losses included in the Statement of Activities. Fair Value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date. See Note 5 for further discussion of fair value measurements.

The Foundation has adopted investment and spending policies which are reviewed peiodically. A new Investment Policy Statement was adopted on May 3, 2018. Within these policies there exists two distinct portions. The first portion is based upon the Louisiana Board of Regents Endowed Chairs / Endowed Professorship / Endowed Scholarship Programs Statement of Investment Policy and Objectives. This portion limits the equity to no more than 74% of the asset allocation and fixed income to at least 26%. The other limitions include that no more than 10% are in hedge funds, 10% in REITS, and 15% in international investments, which are all part of the equity

portion. The second portion is the endowment portion which is based upon a total return philosphy which currently has asset allocation targets of 21% in fixed income, 56% in equities, 3.5% in hedge funds, and 19.5% in private equity.

#### Return Objectives and Risk Parameters

The Foundation has adopted investment and spending policies for endowment assets that attempt to provide a predictable stream of funding to programs supported by its endowment while seeking to maintain the purchasing power of the endowment assets. Endowment assets include those assets of donor-restricted funds that the Foundation must hold in perpetuity. Under this policy, as approved by the Board of Trustees, the endowment assets are invested in a manner that is intended to produce results that exceed price and yield results of the S&P 500 index while assuming a moderate level of investment risk. The Foundation expects its endowment funds, over time, to provide an average rate of return of approximately 7.5 percent to 8.0 percent annually. Actual returns in any given year may vary from this amount.

#### Strategies Employed for Achieving Objectives

To satisfy its long-term rate-of-return objectives, the Foundation relies on a total return strategy in which investment returns are achieved through both capital appreciation (realized and unrealized) and current yield (interest and dividends).

The Foundation targets a diversified assets allocation that places a greater emphassis on equity-based investments to achieve its long-term return objectives within prudent risk constraints. The Foundation invests in multistrategy hedge funds of funds. The investments are a sophisticated, multimanager program designed to achieve an optimal balance of upside return potential and downside protection. The investments offer a diversified strategy protecting and preserving the Foundation's capital and providing long-term capital growth. This strategy also works to deliver risk-adjusted returns by capturing the market's return potential but with much less volatility. The portfolios are constructed using a time tested, disciplined methodology focused first on risk management. The funds have a demonstrated track record of maintaining a highly disciplined and effective investment allocation decision process. The returns from these hedge funds are reported and posted monthly reflecting the fair market value as of the reporting date.

#### Spending Policy and How the Investment Objectives Relate to Spending Policy

The Foundation has a policy of appropriating for distribution each year 4 percent of its endowment fund's average fair value over the prior 5 years through the end of December preceding the fiscal year in which the distribution is planned. In establishing this policy, the Foundation considered the long-

term expected return on its endowment. Accordingly, over the long term, the Foundation expects the current spending policy to allow its endowment to grow at the rate of inflation annually. This is consistent with the Foundation's objective to maintain the purchasing power of the endowment assets held in perpetuity as well as to provide additional real growth through new gifts and investment return.

#### Note 5 - Fair Value Measurements

The Fair Value Measurement and Disclosure Topic 820, section 50 of the Codification establishes a framework for measuring fair value. That framework provides a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. The hierarchy gives the highest priority to unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities (level 1 measurements) and the lowest priority to unobservable inputs (level 3 measurements). The three levels of the fair value hierarchy under ASC 820-50 are described as follows:

- Level 1 Inputs to the valuation methodology are unadjusted quoted market prices for identical assets or liabilities in active markets that the plan has the ability to access.
- Level 2 Inputs to the valuation methodology include:
  - Quoted market prices for similar assets or liabilities in active markets;
  - Quoted prices for identical or similar assets or liabilities in inactive markets
  - Inputs rather than quoted prices that are observable for the asset or liability; and,
  - Inputs that are derived principally from or corroborated by observable market data by correlation or other means.

If the asset or liability has a specified (contractual) term, the level 2 input must be observable for substantially the full term of the asset or liability.

Level 3 Inputs to the valuation methodology are unobservable and significant to the fair value measurement.

The asset or liability's fair value measurement within the fair value hierarchy is based on the lowest level of any input that is significant to the fair value measurement. Valuation techniques used need to maximize the use of observable inputs and minimize the use of unobservable inputs.

Following is a description of the valuation methodologies used for assets measured at fair value. There have been no changes in the methodologies used at June 30, 2019 and 2018.

<u>Investment Securities</u> – The fair value of investment securities including the Bank Trusts investments is the fair market value based on quoted market prices, where available, or Net Asset Value (NAV) or its equivalent as provided by the administrators of each underlying fund.

Money market/certificate of deposit – The fair value of money market accounts are amounts payable on demand at the reporting date. The fair value is based on the present value of each through their respective maturities.

Gift Annuity Liability - The fair value of these agreements is based on the present

value of the estimated future payments based upon management's assumptions.

Hedge Funds – The fair value of investments in this class has been estimated using the NAV practical expedient. Assets so valued are excluded from the Fair Value hierarchy and are included below to facilitate reconciliation to the statement of financial position. The hedge fund invests in directional, relative value, and event-driven hedge fund managed accounts. Although direct valuation techniques and methodologies for Level 3 assets are not completed internally, the Foundation's investment consultant conducts ongoing monitoring and review of fund managers to ensure that reporting and valuation techniques are in accordance with industry standards and best practices. Capital statements, performance, and pertinent news regarding changes in management are scrutinized as an internal part of the due diligence process prior to hiring a fund manager. These same elements are monitored on an on-going basis, as a matter of regular business practice, following the hiring of a manager.

The preceding methods described may produce a fair value calculation that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, although the Foundation believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

#### Note 7 - Gift Annuity Agreements

In October 2005, the Foundation entered into a gift annuity agreement with Paul and Carolyn Lasseigne. As part of the agreement, Mr. and Mrs. Lasseigne gave an irrevocable contribution to the Foundation of \$10,000. Additional contributions can be added to the principal. The Foundation is required to make quarterly payments to them at an annual rate of 5.6% on the cumulative principal balance. These payments will be required for the rest of both of their lives. At the death of both donors, the balance of the annuity corpus will be transferred to the College of Pharmacy Agency fund within the Foundation.

In April 2012, the Foundation entered into a gift annuity agreement with John and Billie Smith. As part of the agreement, Mr. and Mrs. Smith gave an irrevocable contribution to the Foundation of \$250,000. In December 2012, Mr. and Mrs. Smith gave an additional contribution of \$250,000 to the Foundation. Additional

contributions can be added to the principal. The Foundation is required to make quarterly payments to them at an annual rate of 5.6% on the cumulative principal balance originally donated in 2012. In December 2014, Mr. and Mrs. Smith gave an additional contribution of \$500,000. The Foundation is required to make quarterly payments to them at an annual rate of 6.1% on the balance of this contribution. These payments will be required for the rest of both of their lives. At the death of both donors, the balance of the annuity corpus will be transferred to the general assets of the Foundation.

In November 2012, the Foundation entered into a gift annuity agreement with Hugh and Kay McDonald. As part of the agreement, Mr. and Mrs. McDonald gave an irrevocable contribution to the Foundation of \$111,775. The Foundation is required to make monthly payments to them at an annual rate of 4.9% on the balance. Additional contributions can be added. In June 2015, Mr. and Mrs. McDonald gave another irrevocable contribution to the Foundation for \$106,720. The Foundation is required to make monthly payments to them at the annual rate of 6.2% on the principal balance. In October 2016, Mr. and Mrs. McDonald gave another irrevocable contribution to the Foundation for \$136,230. The Foundation is required to make monthly payments to them at the annual rate of 5.40% on the principal balance. These payments will be required for the rest of both of their lives. At the death of both donors, the balance of the annuity corpus will be transferred to the general assets of the Foundation.

At the end of each fiscal year, the related annuity liability is calculated, and the Foundation adjusts the value accordingly. At June 30, 2019 and 2018, the Foundation included the following as an annuity liability.

During the 1992 regular session of the Louisiana Legislature, R.S.17:3384 and R.S.17:3129.5 were amended and reenacted to enable nonprofit organizations of a type described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code to enter into a contract with a public institution of higher education to act as a depository for

Endowed Chairs, Endowed Professorships and Endowed Scholarships derived from state matching funds.

The cumulative original state matching funds as of June 30, 2019 and 2018 are \$7,080,000 and \$6,240,000, respectively and the cumulative total original local matching funds are \$11,400,000 and \$9,300,000, respectively. These cumulative state and local original amounts are included under Funds Held as Agent on the Statements of Financial Position.

For the years ended June 30, 2019 and 2018, the Foundation recognized \$840,000 and \$280,000 respectively, in state matching funds as funds with donor restricted contributions.

#### Note 9 - Funds Available

Included in the Statements of Financial Position under with donor restrictions net assets are funds available for scholarships and academic support. These consist of earnings from invested endowment funds. Changes in funds available during the years ended June 30, 2019 and 2018, were as follows:

#### Note 10 - Endowments

Net assets with donor restrictions at June 30, 2019 and 2018 consists of endowments established in 1970 to support scholarships and programs at the University of Louisiana Monroe. Contributions to the endowment funds are subject to donor restrictions that stipulate the original gift is to be held and invested by the Foundation indefinitely. Income derived from the fund, as prescribed the investment policy statement, is to be expended as prescribed by the donor.

#### Funds with Deficiencies

From time to time, the fair value of assets associated with individual donor-restricted endowment funds may fall below the level that the donor requires the Foundation to retain as a fund of perpetual duration. A contingent reserve for market fluctuation

has been set up. For the year ended June 30, 2019, there was no contingent reserve. There were no projects below their original corpus. The account is monitored and adjusted quarterly. The liablility is included in Other Liabitities on the Statement of Financial Position.

#### Note 11 - Related Party Transactions

On July 1, 2016, the Foundation entered into Cooperative Endeavor Agreements between the ULM Athletic Foundation and the ULM Alumni Association. The Foundation agrees to provide funds administration, investment management, accounting services, data management reporting and other services as mutually agreed. The ULM Athletic Foundation pays \$6,250 monthly and the ULM Alumni Association pays \$1,000 monthly for these services. By virtue of a fifth amendment, the Athletic Foundation has been extended to June 30, 2020 and by fourth amendment, the Alumni Association has been extended to June 30, 2020.

### Note 12 - Commitments and Contingencies

In September 2017, the Foundation Board agreed to fund the interim construction loan for the Laird Weems Center. Construction began in October 2017. As of June 30, 2018, a total of \$562,407 had been advanced from the general fund to the project, and \$239,000 had been repaid with an outstanding balance of \$323,407 as of June 30, 2019. The staff of the Foundation and Alumni Association moved into the building on July 9, 2018. As of the date of this publication, the building is substantially complete except for the payment of retainage of \$2,850.

#### Note 14 - Board Designated Funding

The Foundation has certain board-designated funds that are available for general expenditure within one year in the normal course of operations. These assets are part of the governing board-designated policy.

9/25/2018: **Open Education Resources (OER)** - \$27,000 per year for 3 years to support the redesign of the online general education courses, so that OERs can be used instead of commercial textbooks. The funds will be used to purchase tablet computers, assist with the redesign, and for some meals during meetings. Proceeds from the sale of the Fairbanks property are to be used to fund this initiative.

1/1/2019: University President Funds – The ULM Foundation has funded specific requests received from the University President, in compliance with the Foundation's mission and purpose, from the unrestricted gifts collected from Annual Fund appeals. As such, each January, a total of \$100,000 is transferred as directed by the University President into the President's Advancement Fund, ULM Campus Support & Enhancement Fund, President's Lyceum Series, ULM Marketing & Recruitment Fund and the ULM General Scholarship Fund. The University President is the authorized contact on these projects. Each quarter, accounting reports of activity and balances are provided from the Foundation to the University President.

5/2/2019: Larry & Elizabeth Ann Robinson Superior Graduate Scholarship – The Foundation board voted to prefund \$25,000 for the Larry & Elizabeth Ann Robinson Superior Graduate Scholarship. These funds are to be reimbursed to the Foundation in 2020.

#### Other:

3/13/2019: **Private Equity and Vintage III Funds Investment** – The Foundation Investment Subcommittee recommended and the Board unanimously agreed to commit an additional \$700,000.00 in Goldman Sach's Private Equity Management Program (PEM) as well as \$1,100,000 in their Vintage III Offshore fund from currently invested dollars.

Private equity is an alternative investment class and consists of capital that is not listed on a public exchange. Investors commit capital to private equity funds, raised by private equity firms/ managers, who can take an active role in their portfolio companies. Of the \$1,400,000 committed to private equity by the Foundation to date, only \$172,453 is currently invested as it typically takes five plus years before total funding of the allocated commitment. Funds are called and capital is moved in increments, as private equity investments are determined.

The Vintage Funds are a part of the Alternative Investments & Manager Selection (AIMS) group (multi-asset platform). They are one of the industry's largest and longest standing secondary programs. (Secondaries refers to the buying and selling

of pre-existing investor commitments to private equity and other alternative investment funds). They are becoming a core allocation for private equity investors and have had the highest median IRR (14%) and the second lowest standard deviation across all private equity strategies. They provide lower risk and the potential to outperform other private market strategies. Of the \$1,100,000 committed to Vintage Funds, only \$27,500 has been called to date.
