inadequate Inventory Controls

Villa Peliciana Medical Complex does not have adequate internal controls over inventory. Adequate internal centrols should provide reasonable assurance that inventory bens are properly accounted for and safeguarded.

In our review of the medical complex's inventory controls, the following weaknesses in inventory controls were identified:

- The pharmacy's automated inventory system tracks inventory issues by patient profile rather than by included inventory items.
 - The phention's inventory system only increases the total quantity of items on hand for purchases and does not took included purchases separately nor does it provide a summary of purchases during the year.
 - Documentation of the reconciliation between physical occurs at the pharmacy inventory at June 30, 1697, and recorded amounts at June 30, 1997, see not inventorly. As a should, remarkement of the resolutal contains could not intentify a difference of \$150.488 inherence the value.
 - Management did not adequately recording the June 30, 1997, value of the physical inventory to the June 30, 1007, recorded values for the Central Supply and Wavefeurs Inventories. The unrecorded difference seems of Marie.
 - Central Supply \$31,812 (recorded value exceeded value of physical inventory)
 Warehouse food inventory \$5,921 (value of physical inventory)
 - Werehouse supply inventory 58.213 invoorded value exceeded.

within a timely period. During our review of EDP controls associated with the Concentrated Francial System (DFS) and the Automated Concentrated Purchasing System (ASPS), the following weaknesses were observed:

- identification (IC) codes or the deletion of user ID codes once employee terminates or no longer has a legislanate need for access.
- There are no monitoring procedures to ensure that individuals are permitted access only to the data files and programs necessary to perform their duties.

 In our review of the AGPS, 9 of the 19 users who had access to AGPS did not need the access to perform their duties. Purthermore, our review decisied that two amployees had both data entity and approval accessibles.
