A FUND ACCOUNTING

The financial statements of the Repides Soil and Water Conservation District

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are presented as if the accounts were organized on the basis of funds and account groups, each of which would be considered a separate accounting onthy. Since the District than formarial reaccounts, which are required to be accounted for in other funds, a general hand and a special revenue fund were both employed.

During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2002, the Rapides Sol and Water Conservation District begin receiving funds, which it considers Bpecial Revenue Funds and the financial receival whoe been revenered accordinable.

B. FIXED ASSETS

Fixed assets used in the governmental fund type operations are accounted for in the General Fixed Assets account group, rather than the Governmental Fund. No deprecision has been provided on general fixed assets. All fixed assets are valued at historical cost.

This account group is not a "fund." It is concerned with the measurement of financial contion, not with measurement of operations.

C. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

(2) Expenditures

Expenditures were recognized in the accounting period in which the liabilities are both receivable and incurred.

D. BLOGETARY PRACTICES

A budget was submitted to the Office of Soil and Water Conservation, Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Foresty. State Funding for the year was based upon the allocation procedures established in the program rules and seedaform.
