1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

A FUND ACCOUNTING

B. FIXED ASSETS

Final assets used in the governmental fund type operations are accounted for in the General Fload Assets account group, rather than the Governmental Fund. No deprecision has been provided on general fload assets. All fload assets are volved at Helphonia count.
