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ACCOUNTANT'S COMPILATION REPORT

Management is responsible for the accompanying financial statements of the governmental activities and the major fund of the City Court of Kaplan, Louisiana (City Court), as of and for the year ended June 30, 2022, which collectively comprise the City Court's basic financial statements as listed in the table of contents, in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. We have performed a compilation engagement in accordance with Statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services promulgated by the Accounting and Review Services Committee of the AICPA. We did not audit or review the financial statements nor were we required to perform any procedures to verify the accuracy or completeness of the information provided by management. We do not express an opinion, a conclusion, nor provide any form of assurance on the financial statements.

We did become aware of a departure from accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America that is described in the following paragraph.

The City Court of Kaplan did not adopt the provisions of Governmental Accounting Standards Board Statement No. 84 for the year ended June 30, 2022. The effects of this departure from generally accepted accounting principles have not been determined.

Management has elected to omit substantially all the disclosures required by accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. If the omitted disclosures were included in the financial statements, they might influence the user's conclusions about the City Court's financial position and results of operations. Accordingly, the financial statements are not designed for those who are not informed about such matters.

Management has omitted the Management Discussion and Analysis and Budgetary Comparison Schedule that the Governmental Accounting Standards Board requires to be presented to supplement the basic financial statements. Such missing information, although not a required part of the basic financial statements, is required by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board who considers it to be an essential part of financial reporting and for placing the basic financial statements in an appropriate operational, economic, or historical context.

The accompanying supplementary information on pages 15 through 16 is presented for the purpose of additional analysis and is not a required part of the basic financial statements. Such information is the responsibility of management. The supplementary information was not subject to our compilation engagement. The supplementary information and subject to our compilation engagement. We have not audited or reviewed the supplementary information and do not express and opinion, a conclusion, nor provide any form of assurance on such information.

We are not independent with respect to the City Court.
