## Louisiana Justices of the Peace

### Background

Louisiana’s justices of the peace are locally-elected officials who provide limited judicial services in communities across the state, except for Orleans Parish.<sup>1</sup> Justices of the peace are elected at congressional elections and serve six-year terms within their wards/districts. The next election is scheduled for November 2026. There were 385 justice of the peace jurisdictions in Louisiana as of August 2025.<sup>2</sup>

State law and Code of Civil Procedure<sup>3</sup> grant justices of the peace authority to hear civil cases valued at \$5,000 or less, including eviction proceedings and disputes involving movable property within that limit. In criminal matters, they act primarily as committing magistrates and may issue peace bonds. Justices of the peace cannot preside over cases involving divorce, real estate titles, public office disputes, executory proceedings, or suits against public bodies. The Louisiana Supreme Court provides oversight of justices of the peace, and justices of the peace are required to submit annual financial reports to the Louisiana Legislative Auditor (LLA). To hold office, candidates must meet residency, educational, and character requirements.

### Why We Compiled This Informational Brief

We received a legislative request to provide information related to justices of the peace’s duties, compensation structures, staffing, and sources of revenue. Further, House Resolution 202 of the 2025 Regular Legislative Session requested that the Louisiana Legislative Auditor (LLA) report on the filings of all justices of the peace for the years 2020 through 2025 indicating whether each filed an annual financial report as required by law. To obtain this information, we reviewed annual financial reports submitted to the LLA and surveyed the state’s justices of the peace regarding their salaries, revenues, expenditures, and staffing.

Informational briefs are intended to provide more timely information than standards-based performance audits. While these informational briefs do not follow *Government Auditing Standards*, we conduct quality assurance activities to ensure the information presented is accurate. We provided a draft to select justices of the peace and incorporated their feedback throughout this informational brief.

## What We Found

**Compensation for justices of the peace is primarily set by parish governments dependent on funding.<sup>4</sup> State law<sup>5</sup> also authorizes justices of the peace to collect limited fees,<sup>6</sup> such as those for marriage ceremonies and civil filings.** State law<sup>7</sup> sets the minimum salary for justices of the peace at not less than \$30 per month in all parishes having a population of over 5,000.<sup>8</sup> Justices of the peace do not receive fees in criminal or peace bond cases, but instead receive compensation of not less than \$75 per month if they perform these duties.<sup>9</sup> Based on our review, it appears that most justices of the peace receive a salary and some expense reimbursements, but they do not have medical benefits, life insurance, or retirement benefits as part of the job.

**Compensation** is a broad term that includes salary as well as other benefits such as medical benefits, life insurance, expense reimbursement, and retirement benefits.

State law<sup>10</sup> requires justices of the peace to attend at least one training course offered by the Louisiana Attorney General every other year, or they shall not earn or receive their compensation. In addition, state law specifies fees justices of the peace may receive for performing their duties, such as \$120 for an eviction proceeding or \$40 for a motion for summary judgement. Appendix A details the fees justices of the peace may charge per state law.

**According to annual financial reporting to the LLA and responses to our survey,<sup>11</sup> most justices of the peace, or 317 (96.4%) of 329,<sup>12</sup> reported annual revenues of less than \$100,000 based on charging fees during calendar year 2024.** Further, 285 (86.6%) justices of the peace reported annual revenues of less than \$10,000. Because revenues are based on fees collected for services provided, such as eviction hearings or weddings, justices of the peace in larger jurisdictions with higher populations or a greater number of rental properties will potentially have a higher annual revenue. Conversely, jurisdictions with smaller populations or ones that represent areas that are mostly comprised of farmland or with fewer rental properties may result in lower revenues. For example, justices of

the peace from East Baton Rouge and Jefferson Parishes, the parishes with the two largest populations in Louisiana,<sup>13</sup> reported the largest revenues in calendar year 2024. Exhibit 1 provides the salary and revenues for the 12 justices of the peace with revenues greater than \$100,000 during calendar year 2024, based on annual financial reports submitted to LLA and/or survey results. Appendices B and C contain financial information for calendar years 2023 and 2024 in more detail, respectively.

**Justices of the peace submitted<sup>14</sup> 1,653 (88.0%) of 1,879 statutorily-required<sup>15</sup> financial filings to the LLA for calendar years 2020 through 2024.** State law requires justices of the peace who receive from official duties more than \$200,000 in revenues and other sources in any one fiscal year to submit an annual compilation of its financial statements to the LLA six months after the end of the calendar year (*see text box on the following page*). Any justice of the peace who receives less than \$200,000 from these sources can instead file sworn financial statements 90 days after the end of the calendar year. House Resolution 202 of the 2025 Regular Legislative Session<sup>16</sup> directed the LLA to report on the filings of these financial statements for all justices of the peace for calendar years 2020 through 2025. Because justices of the peace are not required to file the calendar year 2025

statements until March or June 2026, we analyzed these statements through calendar year 2024 only.

For the 385 justice of the peace jurisdictions in Louisiana, we found that 269 (69.9%) reported the required financial information for each year during calendar years 2020 through 2024 as required. We also found that 371 (96.4%) submitted the required information in at least one year, and 13 (3.4%) never filed the required information during these five years. We further noted that total submissions declined to 80.3% in calendar year 2024, from 92.7% in calendar year 2022. During our review of submitted information, we identified instances where required filings were submitted after the deadlines described previously, which could explain why filings for calendar year 2024 have declined as they have yet to be submitted to the LLA. Exhibit 2 summarizes the number and percentage of justices of the peace who submitted required financial information by year, while Appendix D details this information for each jurisdiction by parish.

An **annual compilation of financial statements** is compiled by a certified public accountant (CPA) for the justice of the peace. The CPA’s report that accompanies the compilation gives no assurance as to whether the financial statements are correct.

**Sworn financial statements** include a simple financial statement form that a justice of the peace may self-prepare without the aid of a CPA. The justice of the peace also provides a notarized affidavit with the sworn financial statements affirming they are true and correct and that the justice of the peace received \$200,000 or less during the year.

Because 2025 reports are not due to the LLA until March or June 2026, we are presenting the requested information from 2020 through 2024. In some cases, jurisdictions were vacant during a calendar year and are listed as "Report not Required". In some instances, the justice of the peace did not submit their annual financial reporting but did respond to our survey. When this occurred, this is denoted as a "No" in the table below, but financial information is reported in Appendices B and/or C.
